




1901 DOUBLE BUTLER SINK

Includes 90mm stainless steel waste fittings Double butler sink with waterfall overflow and two equal bowls






1901 BELFAST SINK

Includes 65mm stainless steel waste fitting Single belfast sink with weir overflow






1901 FARMHOUSE SINK

Includes 90mm stainless steel waste fitting Single butler sink with distinctive fielded panel








1901 RIBBLETON SINK

Includes 90mm stainless steel waste fitting Single butler sink with distinctive ribbed front






1901 BUTLER SINK

Includes 90mm stainless steel waste fitting Large single butler sink with plain front






1901 APRON SINK

Includes 90mm stainless steel waste fitting Single butler sink with plain front






1901 LABORATORY SINK 4

Includes 32-40mm chrome waste fitting Medium inset lab sink, installed undermounted or drop-in






1901 LABORATORY SINK 3





CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Each 1901 firectay sink is manufactured with a durable and non-porous finish which carries antibacterial qualities. This means your sink is odour and stain resistant and easy to care for. For cleaning, all that is needed is a soft sponge and a non-abrasive product, such as soap and water. We recommend against using any undiluted chemicals such as bleach.

As our fireclay sinks are handcrafted products, the graduation of the drain may be subtler than in more contemporary models; this means you may need to occasionally wipe the bottom of the bowl.

Occasionally grey marks or lines known as "silvering" may appear on the surface, caused by metal pans or cutlery. To remove these, we recommend using a fine car polish or a cream cleanser such as Jif, along with a non-scratch scourer.

Fireclay is more resistant to scratches, chips and stains than other types of ceramic, however care still needs to be taken, especially when using heavy items such as cast-iron pans.

INSTALLATION TIPS

Due to their handcrafted nature, the measurements of 1901 sinks can vary up to 2%. Ensure you have received and measured your sink before you begin cabinet and benchtop construction.

When installing a fireclay sink we recommend you seal between the sink and the benchtop. Any sealant used where the sink meets a stone benchtop needs to be flexible (we recommend mould resistant silicone) rather than rigid (like stone adhesive). This will allow for any difference in expansion rates between the stone and the sink.

When installing the waste fitting, it is important to use a continuous run of silicone sealant between the metal waste flange (the part that you will see in the sink around the plug) and the glazed sink itself. This prevents water from draining under the flange when the sink is filled. Please note that if surfaces are cleaned with a cloth dampened with mineral turps the silicone adheres very well. Also use the same cloth to clean up any excess silicone that squeezes out when the waste fitting is tightened. Ensure that the silicone is cleaned up before it dries.

WARRANTY

The 1901 range of firectay sinks come with a 10 year replacement warranty against any manufacturing faults. Our firectay sinks have proven their superior quality and customers can be confident they are installing a premium product.

Please ensure you follow the recommended installation tips when installing your 1901 sink. If our care and maintenance guidelines and installation recommendations are followed, you will be able to enjoy your fireclay sink for many decades to come.
